





Chamonix is a Skiing Destination

It has diverse ski terrain for all skill levels. Chamonix is on the **IKON Pass**, or you can purchase a Mont Blanc pass when there.

Ski Areas under IKON

- **Grands Montets** – steep terrains with access to high alpine areas for advanced skiers
- **La Balme (Le Tour/Vallorcine)** – for those preferring gentler slopes
- **Brevent/Flegere** – connected areas offering stunning views of Mont Blanc Valley, with terrain for all ski levels
- **Les Houches/St. Gervais** – tree-lined runs that are great options for flat-light days

And now...

IKON includes Courmayeur, Italy!

- Ski the heart of Valle d'Aosta – Courmayeur is called "Italy's best all-round ski resort"
- Public buses run from Chamonix to Courmayeur
- From the top you can see the Matterhorn 50km away
- Savor delicious Italian cuisine at lunch or après in chic cafés on mountain or in town



Some Things to Do (Besides Skiing)

A Variety of Activities...



- Ride the Montenvers cogwheel train to see the Mer de Glace glacier and ice cave
- Snowshoe and explore winter wonderlands
- Drive or ride a husky sled through snowy forests and meadows.
- Paraglide for the ultimate bird's eye view of Chamonix
- Go ice skating with a stunning backdrop of snow-capped peaks
- Try your hand at ice climbing
- Guided tours/mountain excursions for hiking, backcountry skiing, etc.

Aiguille du Midi

- **Cable Car Ride:**

The main cable car takes you from Chamonix to an altitude of 12,605 feet, placing you across from Mont Blanc.

- **Viewing Platforms:**

Several terraces provide incredible 360° views of the French, Swiss, and Italian Alps.

- **"Step Into the Void":**

A unique visitor skywalk made of reinforced glass box suspended over a 1,000-meter drop.

- **Ski Vallée Blanche:**

Vallée Blanche is the off-piste glacier of the French Alps at the heart of outstanding glacial landscapes.





Annecy

Known as the “Venice of the Alps” because of its beautiful, preserved medieval old town with canals, stone footbridges, the stunning Lake Annecy, and surrounding mountain scenery

The town has a vibrant market and regional cuisine featuring local cheeses. It also has historical sites like

- the Palais de L'Isle, a former prison and courthouse,
- the Château d'Annecy, which now houses a museum
- the five bell towers district
- Le Pâquier, considered the “Central Park of Annecy.”

 - Departs Newark February 27 at 5:35pm, arriving Geneva Saturday, February 28 at 7:25am
 - Returns from Paris Tuesday, March 10 at 12:55pm, arriving Newark 4:40pm
- Deluxe round-trip bus transfer from Geneva to Chamonix and back
- 7-nights lodging (double occupancy) at Lykke Hotel & Spa
- Welcome reception/cocktail and resort orientation after arrival
- European buffet breakfast daily
- Dinner at hotel seven evenings
- Taxes, surcharges and fees
- It does **NOT** include lift tickets.

Trip to Paris extension includes:
